We welcome school and nursery visits and have the facilities and resources in place to ensure you have an enjoyable, educational and rewarding visit.


You can just visit the farm and play areas which is a brilliant trip in itself. Or to make it extra special and memorable, you can add a bespoke lesson or activity to your visit.

What's there?

ANIMAL FEEDING | Cows, ponies, pigs and sheep, llamas, alpacas, rabbits, and guinea pigs!

ACTIVITIES | Bespoke lessons, seasonal activities and animal encounters.

PLAY AREAS | Outdoor fort and swings, giant indoor sandpit and huge indoor play area.

FACILITIES | Cafe, picnic areas, classroom, toilets, coach and minibus parking.

Benefits to children

LESSONS (additional to the £8 farm entry per child)

1. Wheat & Flour

Lesson

Children learn how wheat is converted into flour. Includes an interactive activity of grinding grains of wheat, followed by a flashcard activity showing the different stages and process of production from planting and harvest, to what foods contain flour. **Cost per child: £1.00**

Additional Fun Activity

Children create a "flour pal" to take home with them (balloon filled with flour, complete with funny face and hair!). **Cost per child: £2.00**



3. Animal Products

Lesson

Children are taught about what we get from different animals, including sheep, cows, chickens and pigs. Includes a flashcard activity to match the different foods and materials with the right animal. **Cost per child: £1.00**

Additional Fun Activity

Children are given craft materials to make a chicken using cardboard, feathers and googly eyes. **Cost per child: £2.00**

2. Soil Testing

Lesson

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A practical lesson about different soil types - sandy, clay and loamy. Includes an activity to identify the different soils by seeing what shapes they can be moulded into when damp, plus information on what grows best in each soil type.

Cost per child: £1.00

Additional Fun Activity

Children make a flower seed bomb each to take home or back to school/nursery to plant and watch grow. **Cost per child: £2.00**



4. Crop Care

Lesson

A lesson learning about the impact extreme weather conditions, pests and humans can have on crop growth. Includes a flashcard activity matching the different factors with the types of crop damage. **Cost per child: £1.00**

Additional Fun Activity

Children each plant a bean on cotton wool to take home or back to school/nursery with them so they can watch it sprout and grow. **Cost per child: £2.00**





SEASONAL EXPERIENCES (additional to the £8 farm entry per child)

1. Mini Beasts

Come and explore the farm and see what creepy crawlies you can find on our Mini Beast Adventure. Suitable for all ages. **Cost per child: £1.00**

2. Pond Dipping

An activity suitable for all ages, come and explore the Mini Meadows Farm pond, bursting with wildlife. Discover the wide range of plants and insects that live in and around the pond. **Cost per child: £1.00**

Time of Year April - September



3. Bottle Feeding

Bottle feed our cade lambs; it's a fun, interactive experience for all ages. Depending on group size and the number of lambs we have, it is recommended a bottle between two children, or one each if requested. **Cost per child: £1.00**

4. Animal Encounter

Is there a particular animal at the farm you would like to know more about on your visit? Includes a talk about the animal, fun facts and petting if possible. Please ask when you first enquire about the animals that we can include. **Cost per child: £1.00**

FAQs

WHAT SHOULD THE CHILDREN WEAR?

Warm clothes, waterproofs and wellies in cold/wet weather. Suncream and sunhats for warmer months. WHAT'S INCLUDED IN THE PRICE?

Minimum £8 per child includes entry to the farm, play areas and room hire. Additional to the entry price are lessons £1 per child, lesson-related fun activity £2 per child, and seasonal experiences.CAN WE JUST VISIT THE FARM WITHOUT ADDING AN ACTIVITY/LESSON?

Yes absolutely! It's just £8 per child and £8 per adult, and includes room hire if it's a group booking. IS THERE A MINIMUM/MAXIMUM NUMBER FOR A GROUP BOOKING?

Minimum five children, maximum 100.

ARE THERE PICNIC AREAS?

Yes. We have picnic tables indoors and outdoors, and you will have a private room hired too. WHAT'S THERE TO DO IN WET WEATHER?

Lots of our animals are indoors/undercover, plus we also have the huge indoor Treetops play area and the giant indoor sandpit. But we do encourage you to enjoy the outdoors, even in the rain! IS THERE COACH PARKING?

> Yes. There is plenty of parking and space for coaches to turn around. ARE THERE DISABLED FACILITIES?

We have disabled toilets, wide pathways outside and ramps for easy access into the different buildings. IS THERE A RISK ASSESSMENT AVAILABLE?

Yes. Once you book we will make sure you are sent our risk assessment, and you are very welcome to come along to the farm before your visit to carry out your own if you wish.

CANCELLATION POLICY?

If you need to cancel, then we ask that you notify us at least 24 hours before your visit.





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
